Action Tool Title		Residency Waiver for In-State Tuition Rates	
Description of the tool:		Give In-State tuition rates to businesses' employees and family members relocating to Texas	
How Well Does It Work?			
<b>How valuable is this tool? How important is its contribution to achieving North Texas' vision for the future?</b>			
This action tool allows for more people to have access to Texas tuition rates and allows them to avoid paying higher out of state tuition rates if they are moving into Texas for job relocation.			
<b>How does it actually work?</b>			
Relocating students from companies/businesses/corporations must submit an application to the college or university for In-State Tuition on behalf of themselves saying that they will establish permanent residence in the State of Texas. Or the city/municipality should submit a letter of request for consideration to the Executive Director of the Economic Development & Tourism division of the Office of the Governor on behalf of the business they wish to relocate to Texas. The letter should indicate how many employees need to be transferred, what the wages are, and the capital investment of the project. The plans the business needs to submit are how the company will impact the particular region in Texas and their plans for growth as a company. If the company is approved, then their name appears on a company list for those that receive in-state tuition.
